PROGRAM & COURSE NOTES

FACULTY & UNIVERSITY REQUIREMENTS

In addition to the listed courses, you must satisfy all requirements for the Faculty of Human and Social Development, as well as complete at least 30 of their minimum 60 required units at UVic. Within these 60 units, 21 units must be upper-level (300/400-level) courses, and 18 of those 21 units must be taken at UVic.

ACADEMIC WRITING REQUIREMENT (AWR)

If you have not already satisfied UVic's Academic Writing Requirement (AWR), you will need to complete one of ENGL135, 146, 147, or another approved course. If you have already satisfied the AWR on admission, you can instead select 1.5 units of electives.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

You are responsible for the completeness and accuracy of your registration and for determining the requirements of your program.

Always read course descriptions before you register to determine if you have the necessary prerequisites and pay attention to notes on mutually-exclusive and cross-listed courses (pairs of courses in which credit will be awarded for only one option).

FOOTNOTES

1. Students **without** credit for Biology 12 or Physiology and Anatomy 12 must complete a total of 3.0 units of electives and one of the following: EPHE 141 or BIOC 102 or BIOL 150A or BIOL 150B.

Students with credit for Biology 12 or Physiology and Anatomy 12 must complete a Request for Change to CAPP form and take 4.5 units of electives.

2. HINF 202 must be taken prior to first co-op work term. Normally completion of all courses listed in first and second year will be required prior to undertaking the 1st work term.
3. Students are required to select a minimum of 7.5 units from the list of **Approved Senior Electives** to complete their degree.
